This quickly turns to immense grief as baby Connor dies as the result of a heart defect.

This is a true NZ story shown through the eyes of his brother.

The young boy recounts the memories of joy and sadness at the birth and then death of his new born brother Connor.

Some years later, now with another brother and sister he looks back to the sad experience through the open honest eyes of a child.

This book is recommended as a way to talk through a baby's death with siblings. It is straightforward with a hint of humour as it follows an extended family through baby loss.
